

# Good Samaritan Training...Are You Ready?

The biblical Good Samaritan was able to serve because he knew what to do. Would you know what to do in similar circumstances? The Harris County Citizens Corps' Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) will be presenting its free 8-week training to prepare you to serve your family, neighbors, and the Copperfield area in the event of a natural or man-made disaster (e.g., hurricane, tornado, plant explosion). You'll learn about basic fire-fighting, light search and rescue, firt aid, chemical/nuclear/biological events, disaster psychology, and much more. The training is presented by experts from the FBI, Cy-Fair Volunteer Fire Department, Harris County Office of Emergency Management and other.

There is no cost for the training and you are not required to do anything after graduation. A backpack of basic disaster response supplies is provided free of charge to all CERT graduates. The training is brought to you by Harris County Judge Emmett as part of Harris County's disaster preparedness activities. The training will be held on Wednesday evenings (6 pm to 9 pm) at Cy-Fair College from September 5 to October 24.
